

Parish Newsletter 15th September 2024



This Sunday, we celebrate Home Mission Sunday, also known as Evangelii Gaudium Sunday, a day dedicated to the mission of the Church here in England and Wales. It is a day when we are reminded of our calling to share the joy of the Gospel, not just abroad but in our own communities, homes, and parishes. As Pope Francis emphasized in his apostolic exhortation Evangelii Gaudium, we are called to be joyful witnesses of Christ's love, reaching out to those who may feel distant or disconnected from the Church, and bringing the light of Christ into their lives.

The Gospel today perfectly complements this call to mission, as Jesus asks His disciples, "Who do you say I am?" Peter, speaking with boldness, declares, "You are the Messiah." This moment is pivotal in the life of the disciples and for us as well. It calls us to reflect on who Jesus truly is for each of us, and how this understanding shapes our lives and our mission. Jesus reveals that His kingship is not one of worldly power or glory, but of self-sacrificial love—a love that leads to the cross. To follow Him means to take up our own crosses, living lives of service and self-denial, for the sake of others and the Gospel.

As we reflect on Home Mission Sunday, we are reminded that this mission begins in our own hearts. It starts with our personal encounter with Jesus through prayer, the sacraments, and the Scriptures. But our mission mustn't be confined to the walls of the church, extending to our families, workplaces, and neighbourhoods, where we can be living witnesses of Christ's love.

As a parish community, we are invited to ask how we can support each other in this mission of evangelisation. There is much good work already happening in our parish through catechesis, sacramental preparations, and various ministries. Yet, Home Mission Sunday encourages us to discern if there is more we can do to grow together in faith and reach out to those who may be distant from the Church. Perhaps this is an invitation to reflect on how we can use our God-given talents to serve both within the parish and beyond, building up the Body of Christ in all we do.

This Sunday a small group of pilgrims will walk to Kemsing to venerate St Edith, our local saint. They will carry with them the prayers and intentions of the whole parish, and I encourage all of you to join them, either by walking alongside them or through prayer. This pilgrimage is a reminder that we are all on a journey together, united in Christ, as we seek to deepen our faith and share His love with others.

As we move through this week, let us pray for the grace to embrace our mission with joy, taking up our crosses and following Christ.
