Parish Newsletter 25th August 2024



This week we arrive at a significant moment in our journey through the Scriptures. This 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time brings to a close our recent reflection on the Eucharist, and we are asked to choose, like the Twelve Apostles, whether to follow Jesus or turn back to former ways of life.

In today's First Reading, Joshua challenges the Israelites to decide whom they will serve: the Lord or the foreign gods of the surrounding nations. This moment of decision mirrors our own spiritual crossroads. For the past several weeks, we have contemplated the profound mystery of the Eucharist — the gift of Christ's Body and Blood given for the life of the world. Now, as we stand before this mystery, we are asked to choose whether we will fully embrace it or turn away from it.

The Gospel shows us many disciples struggling with Jesus' teaching about the Eucharist. They murmur among themselves, finding it hard to accept the reality of eating His Flesh and drinking His Blood. Some even walk away. Yet, in the face of this challenge, Peter stands firm. Speaking on behalf of the Twelve, he declares, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." Peter's response invites us to make a similar choice: to stand with Christ, trusting in His words even when they are difficult to understand. This decision is not unlike the choice Joshua presented to the Israelites at Shechem. There, Joshua uraed the Twelve Tribes to renew their covenant with God, much as we are called to renew our commitment to Christ through the Eucharist. The Eucharist is our daily miracle — a source of life that sustains us on our journey to the new homeland God has promised. Through this sacrament, we are united with Christ, sharing in His divine life and love.

This week, let us reflect deeply on this choice. Whom will we serve? Let us choose wisely, embracing the wisdom of God and living a life centred on Christ and the Eucharist.




