

## Dear Parishioners and Visitors over this Christmas period,



## HEALTH & SAFETY DURING THE CHURCH SERVICES

As we gather for our Christmas services and celebrations, we want to ensure that everyone remains safe and secure. Please take note of the following fire safety and emergency procedures, which apply to all our churches during this special season:

- $\Rightarrow$  Awareness of Exits: On arrival, take a moment to familiarise yourself with the nearest exit routes. In the unlikely event of a fire or emergency, our church wardens, clear signposting and guidance will help direct you to safety.
- $\Rightarrow$  **Emergency Evacuation Procedure:** In the event of a fire or if the lights should fail, please remain calm and follow the directions given by parish volunteers and staff. They are trained to assist in evacuation, to use torches, and to guide everyone to the exits. Do not attempt to re-enter the church until it is confirmed safe to do so.
- $\Rightarrow$  Use of Candles: Only permitted candle types can be used, and wherever possible we will opt for battery-operated candles rather than open flames. If you are carrying a candle, please keep it upright and away from clothing, children, and decorations, following any instructions given by stewards or volunteers.
- ⇒ Children's Safety: At any time in church please supervise your children and do not let them wander around, especially near the votive candle stands, toilets, or emergency exits. Please remember that children under any circumstance are not allowed to light votive candles without an adult present right next to them. During nativity plays or carol services with children participating, there will be designated supervisors who will guide them. If an evacuation is necessary, please follow the stewards' instructions and remember that children will be led to the assembly point outside, where they can safely be reunited with their families.
- $\Rightarrow$  **No Overloading of Electrical Equipment:** For everyone's safety, please do not tamper with any lighting or electrical cables. Overloading sockets or using damaged cables can cause overheating and spark a fire. Our team will ensure all lighting and sound equipment is used safely.
- ⇒ Personal Belongings and Mobility Aids: Keep aisles and exit routes clear of personal belongings, prams, or mobility aids. If you require additional assistance, please inform a steward upon arrival.

By cooperating with these guidelines, you help us ensure a joyful, prayerful, and safe environment for all. Thank you for your understanding and vigilance during our Christmas celebrations.
